Samuel Pepys starts to record the unfolding events in his diary.



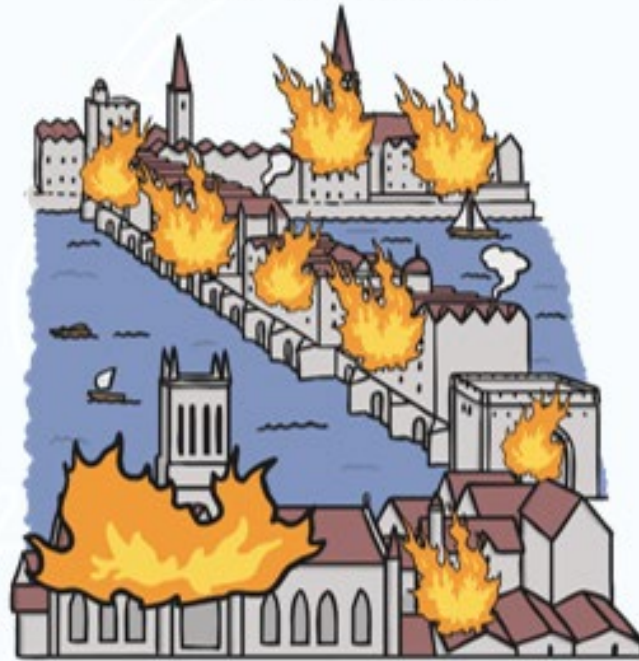
Sunday evening

River Thames.



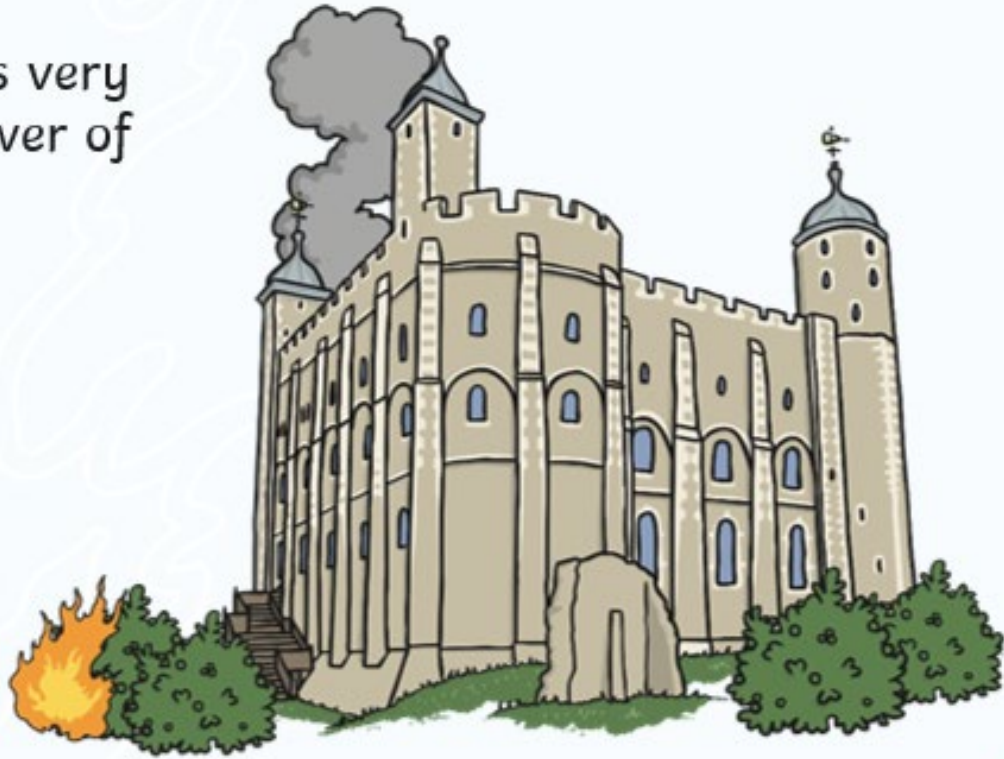
Late Monday morning

near the fire.

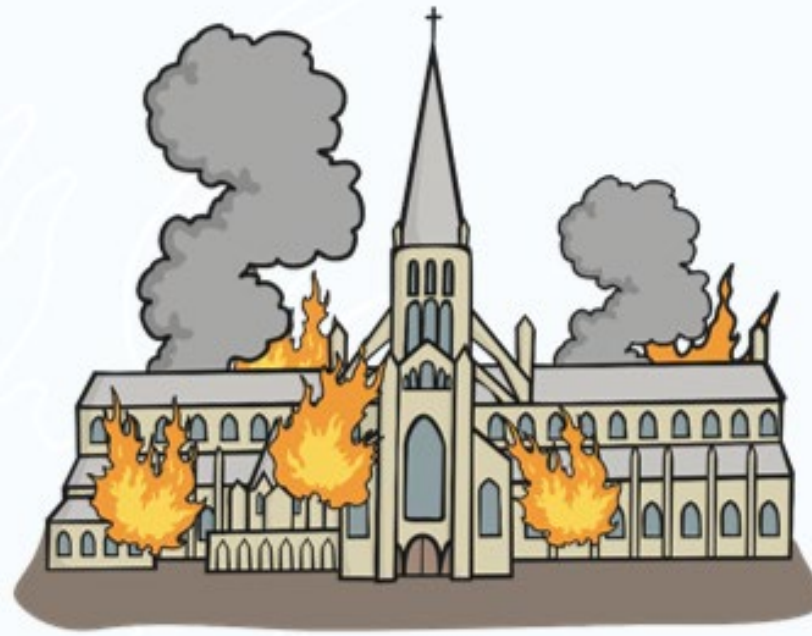
Monday evening
