99% agree or strongly agree child is safe at school

98% agree or strongly agree children are well behaved

82% agree or strongly agree that bullying is dealt with. 16% didn't know, one parent commented that they didn't know because this had never been an issue.

98% agree or strongly agree school is well led and managed

97% agree or strongly agree school responds to concerns

98% agree or strongly agree that they have information on child's progress. One parent commented that her son always loses things from his bag.

98% agree or strongly agree that they would recommend the school to other parents.

We are pleased with our results and are always looking at ways to improve. We think that 2% of our parents who strongly disagreed that their child is happy at school were returned from parents of new starters in nursery school.
