- Complete activities to support understanding of shapes

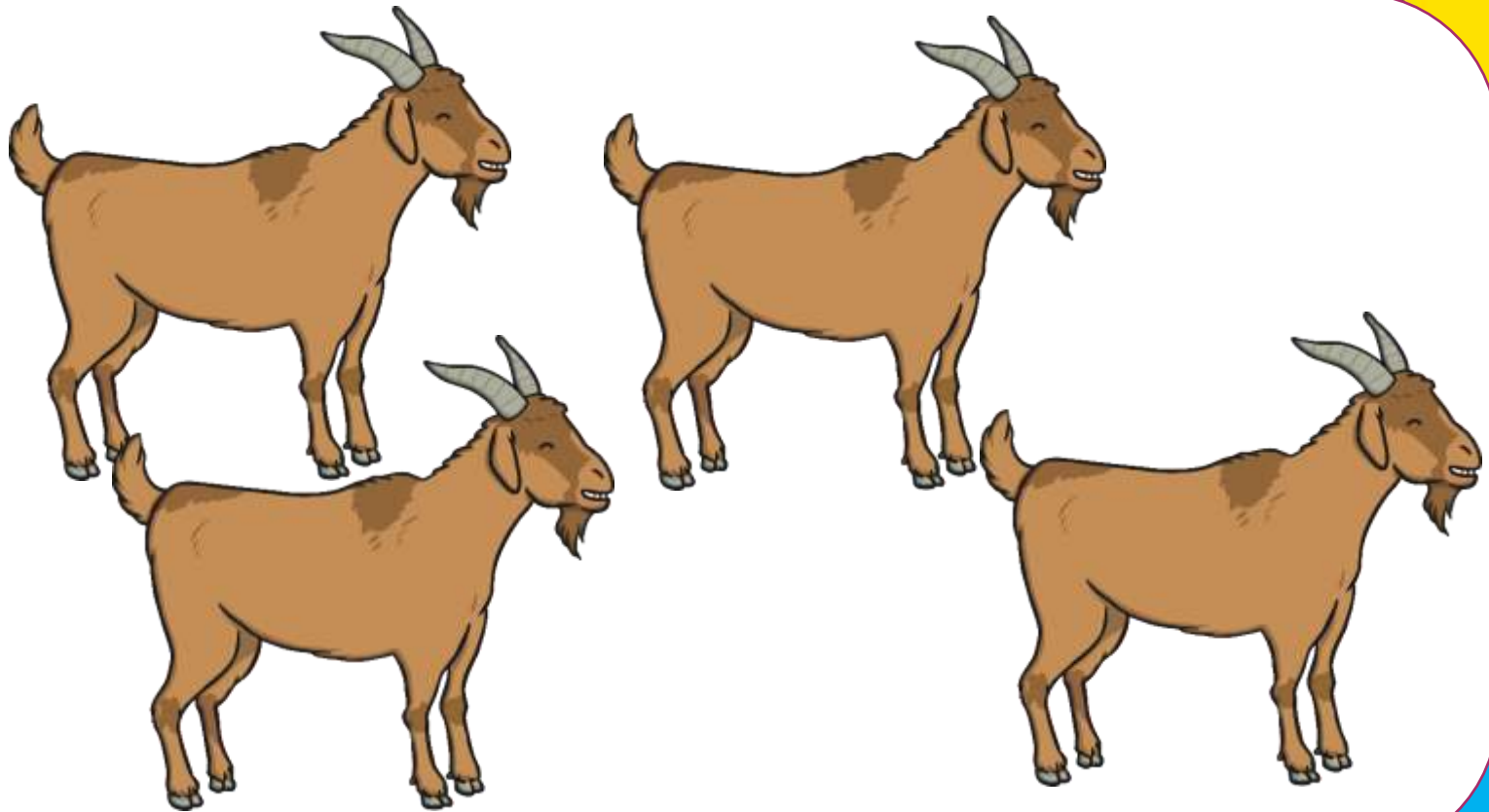
Counting Activity Parental Notes

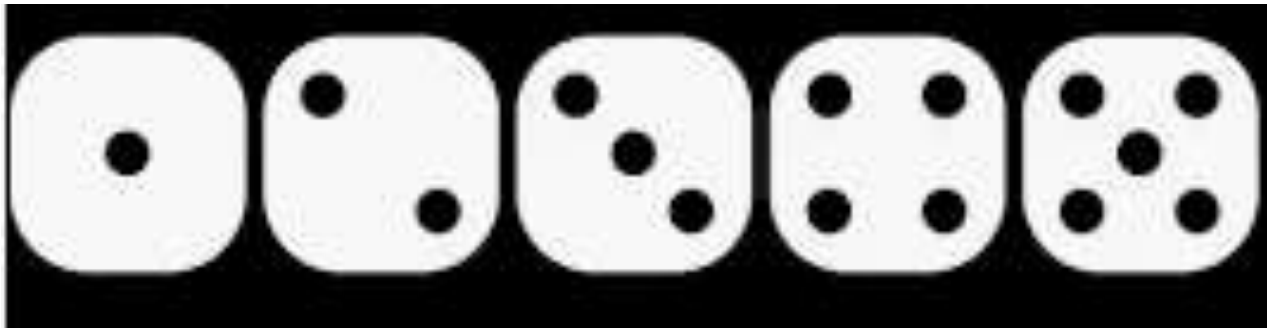

There are no corners to be found.

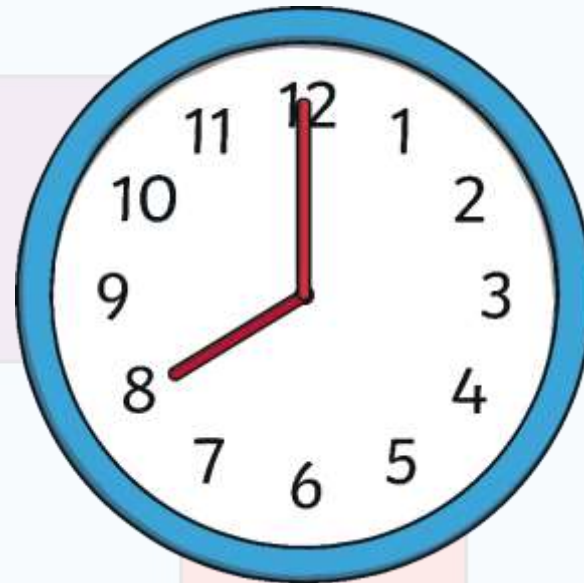
You can make me roll, easily,
Because I'm as round as can be.



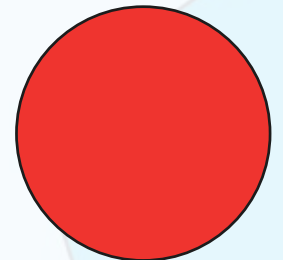

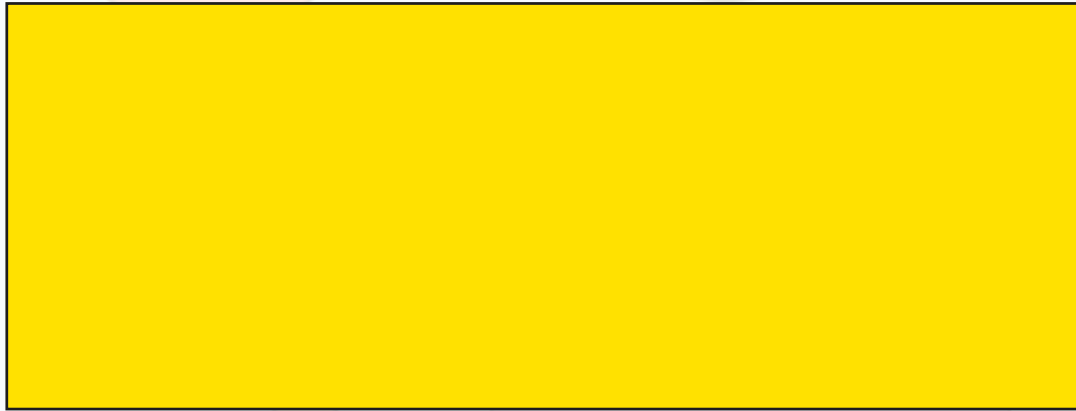

The Rectangle Song

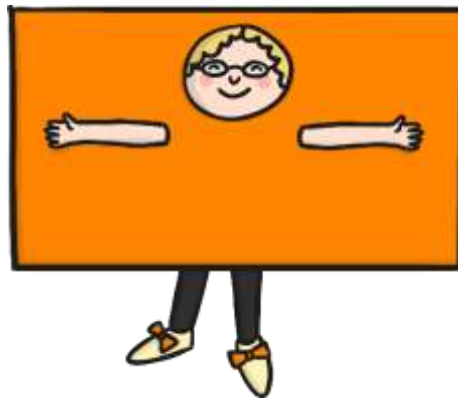
Sing to the tune of '**London Bridge Is Falling Down**'

Two long sides and two short sides,

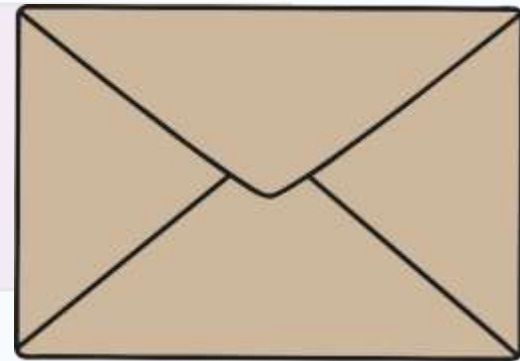
With four corners.





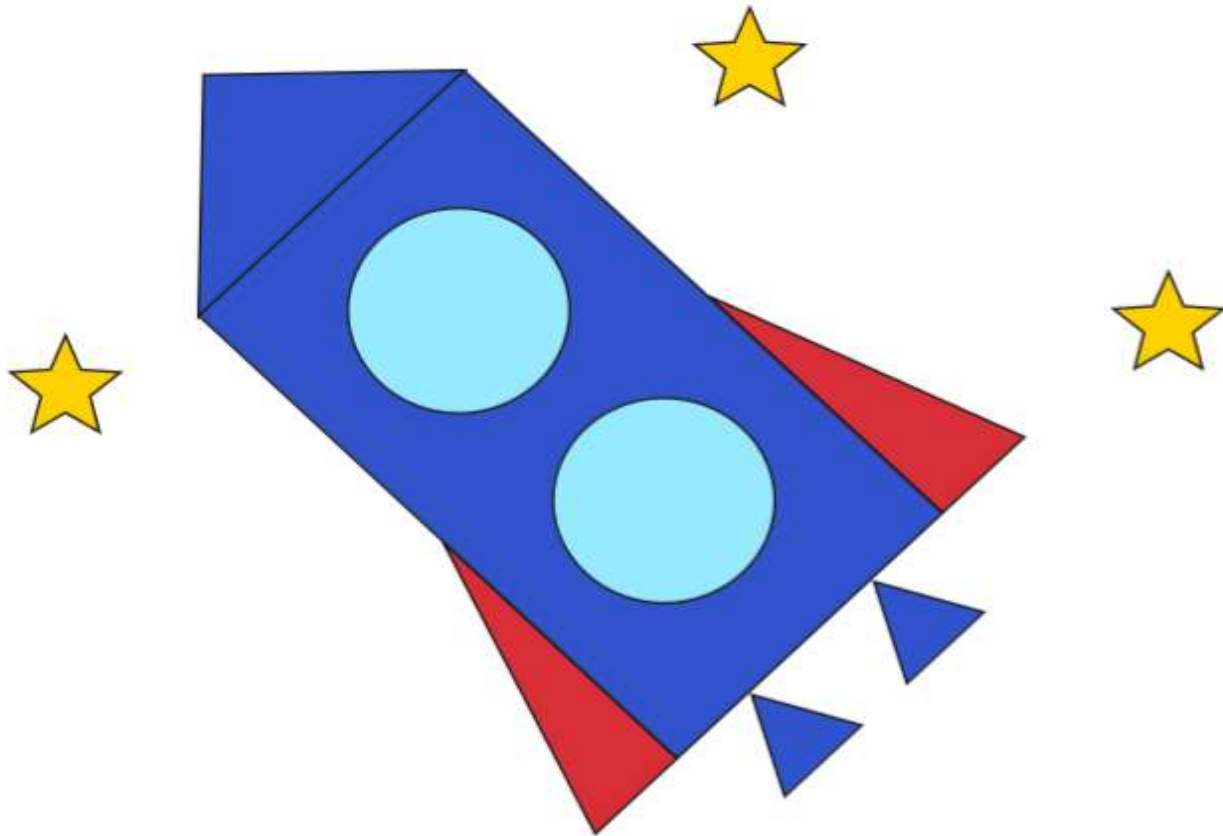
