

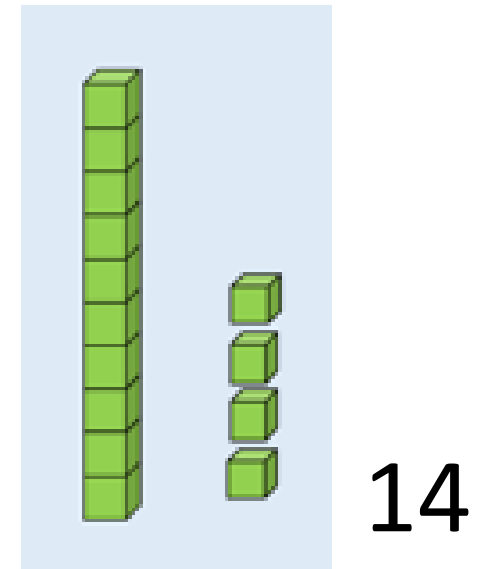
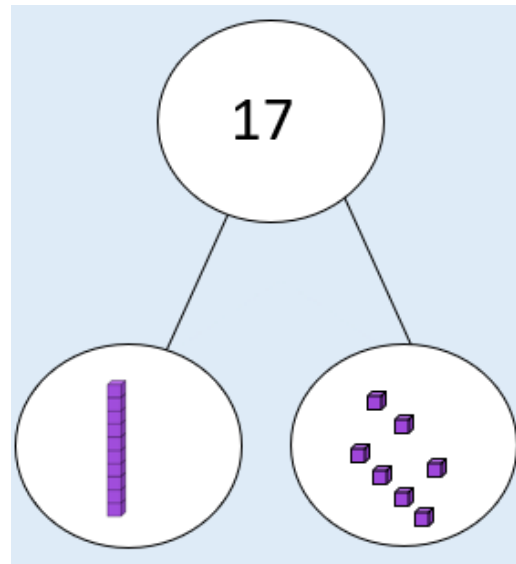
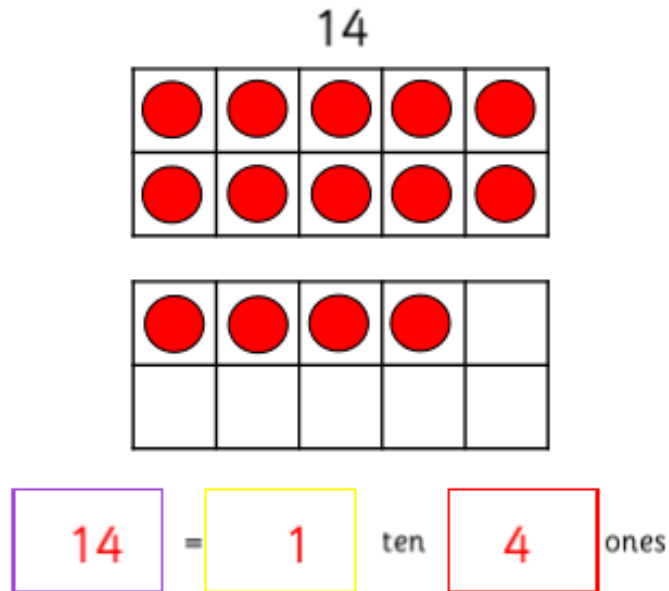

Remember teen numbers are made up of one 10 and ones.

Here are some examples to remind you:

Show 16.

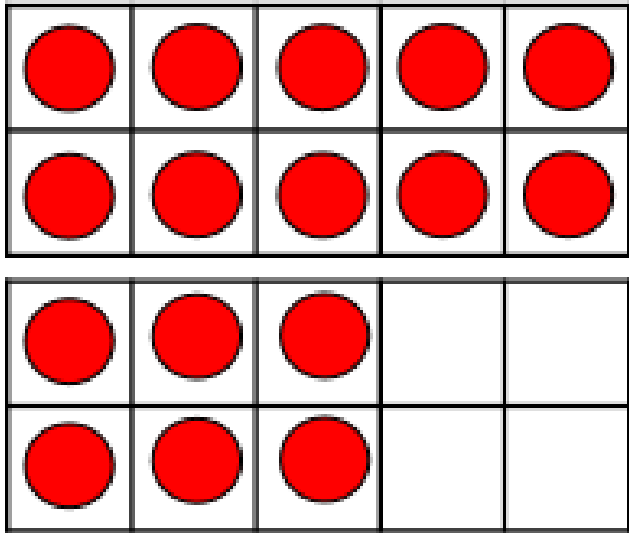
= ten ones

= ten one

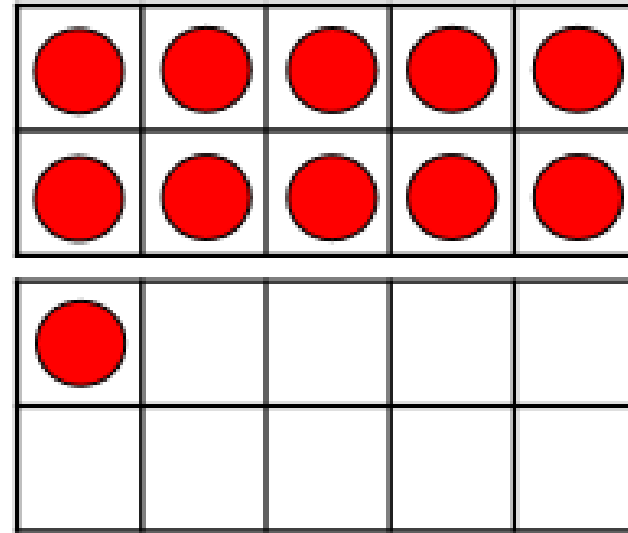

$$16 = 1 \text{ ten } 6 \text{ ones}$$

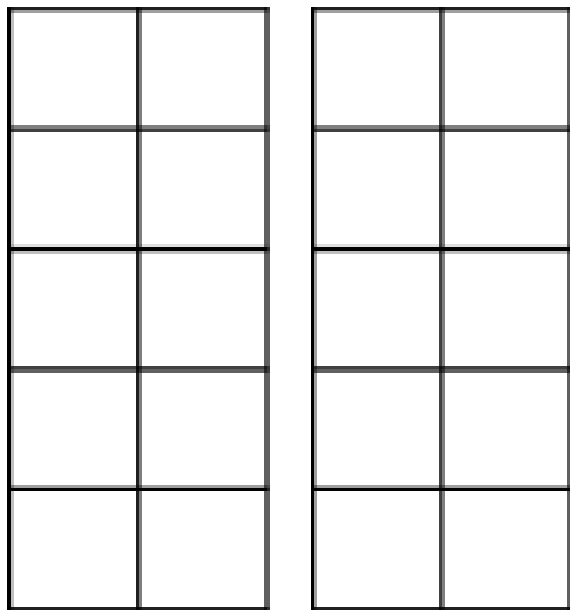
Show 11.



$$11 = 1 \text{ ten } 1 \text{ one}$$

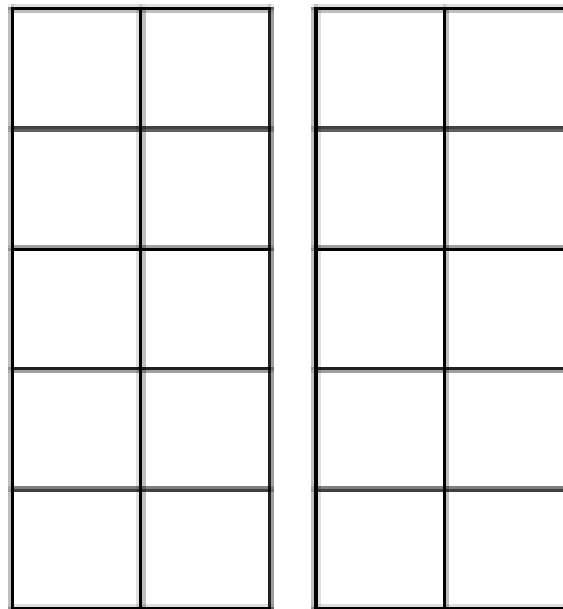

= ten ones

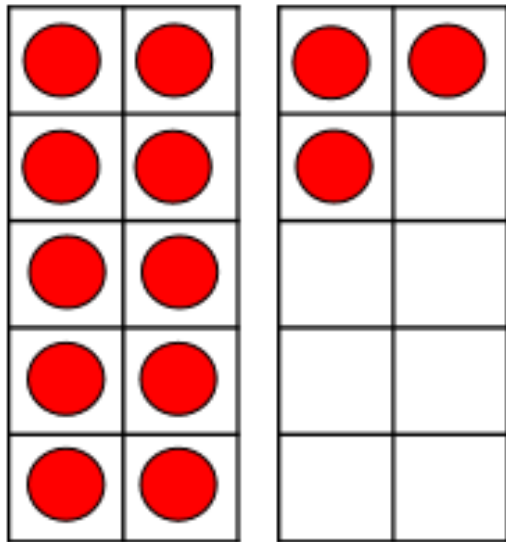
Show 20.



= tens ones

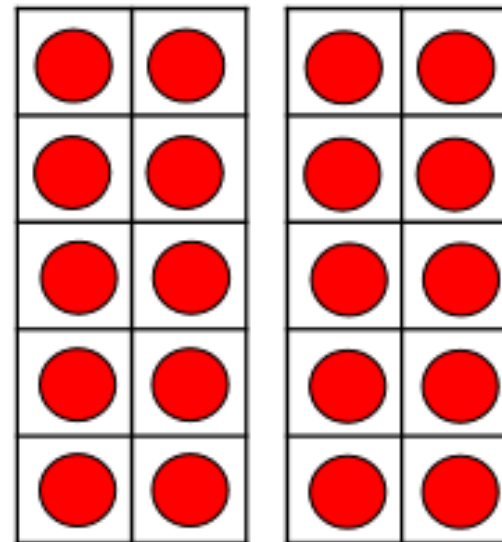

= ten ones

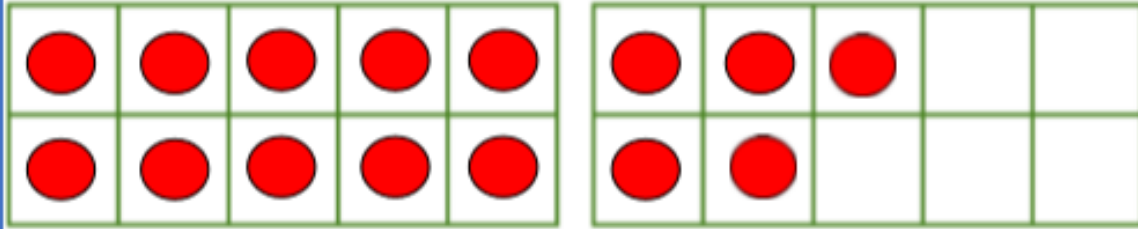
Show 18.



= ten ones

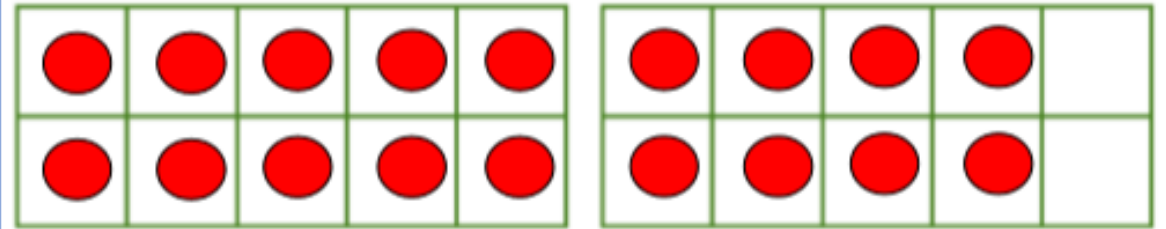

$$15 = 1 \text{ ten } 5 \text{ ones}$$

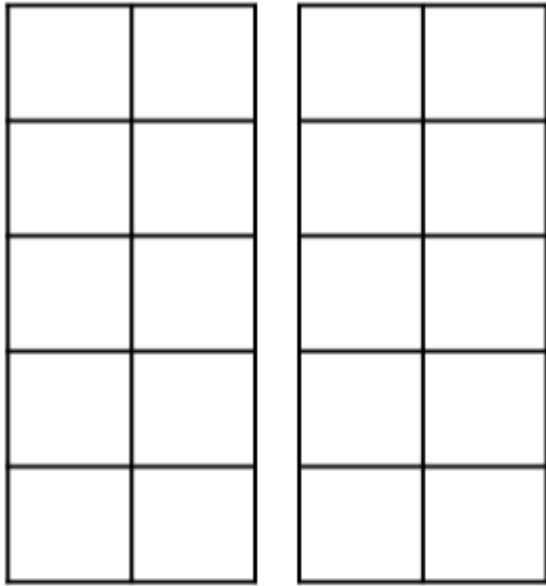

$$18 = 1 \text{ ten } 8 \text{ ones}$$

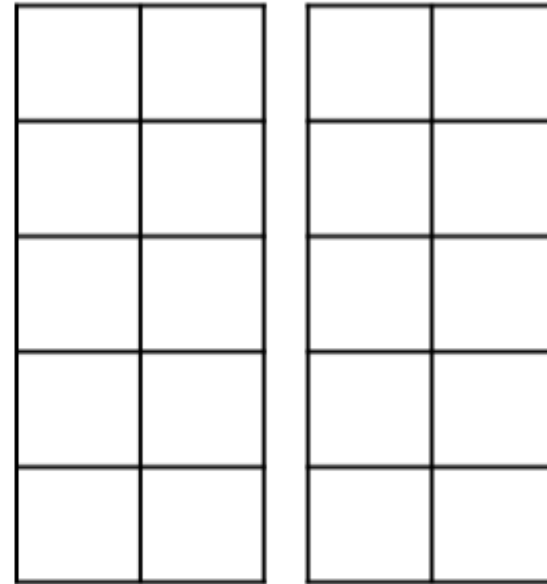
