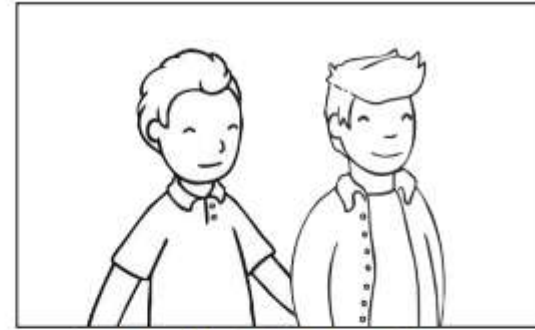
The Coin in the Soil



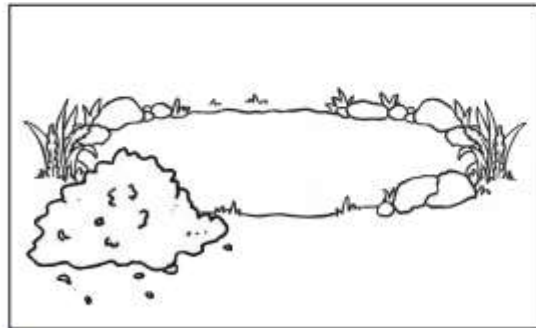
Long ago, a boat with a pointy mast set sail.
