Animals in nature have a habitat. This habitat provides them with everything they need.

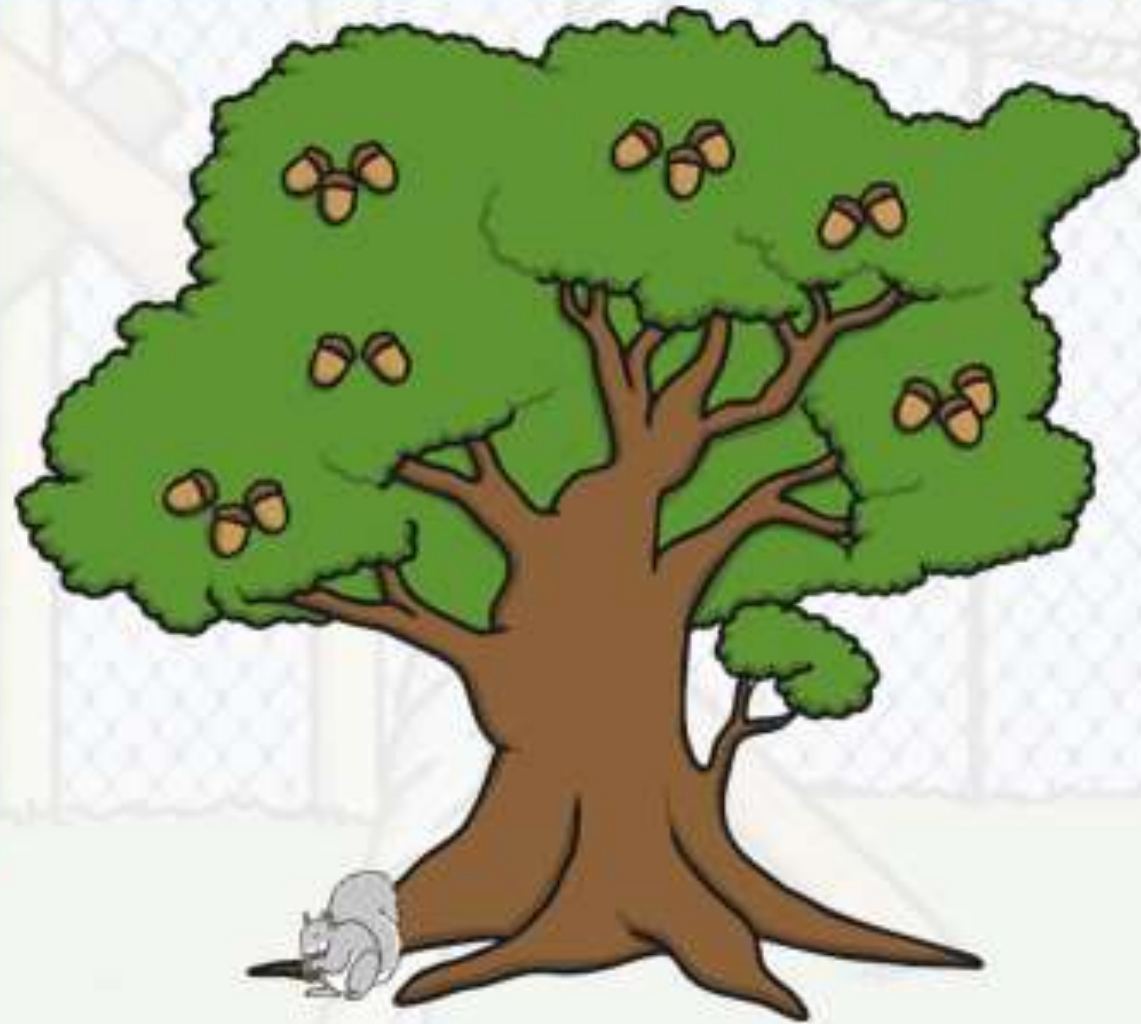
This squirrel lives in a hole in an oak tree.

We keep animals in zoos.

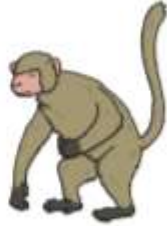
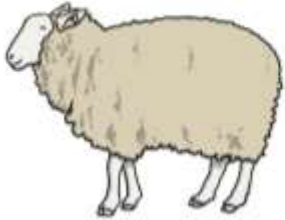


We keep animals on farms.

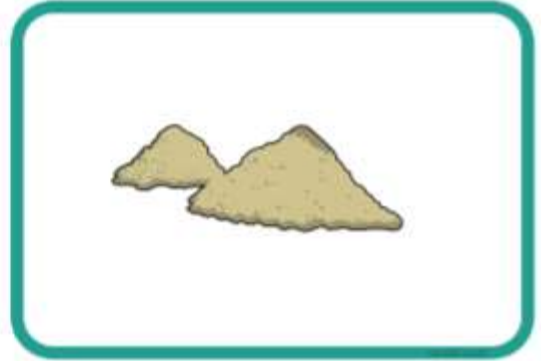
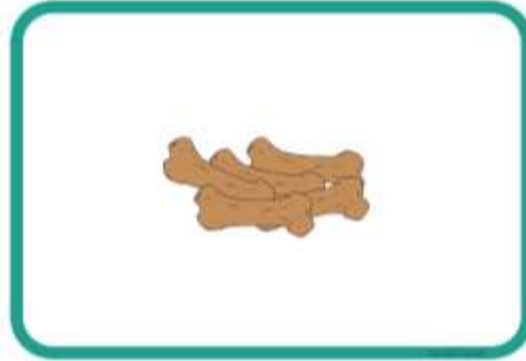
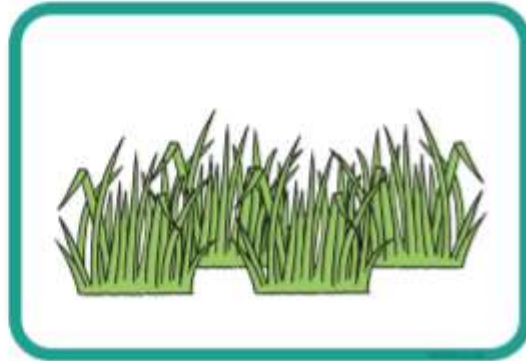
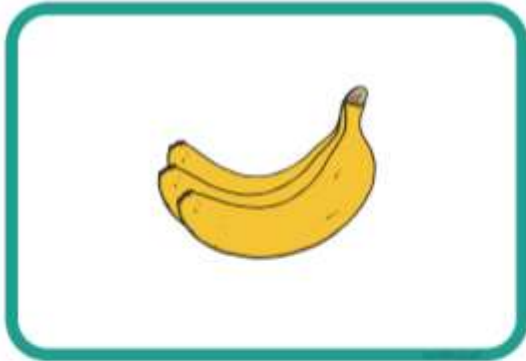


All of these animals need to be cared for in different ways, to make sure they have a healthy, happy life.

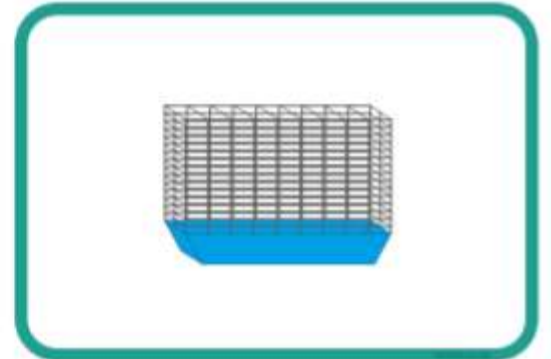
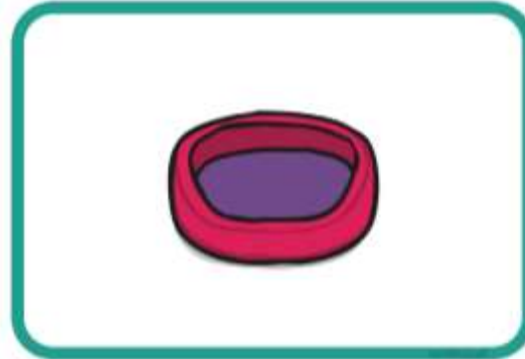
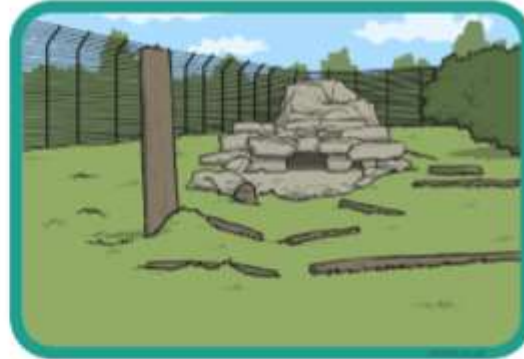
