Welcome Back!

We are very much looking forward to welcoming all of our pupils back to school on Monday 8th March 2021. We would like to thank all parents, carers and pupils for their efforts in ensuring excellent engagement levels in remote learning. You have all been amazing! 😊

You can be reassured that we continue to have a rigorous risk assessment in place to ensure school is as safe as possible for all of our pupils, parents/carers and staff.

One of the ways we can make the school grounds as safe as possible is to ask that only **one parent/carer drops their child off and picks them up from school and that all parents/carers wear a face covering whilst on school grounds, as well as keeping a 2 metre distance from other parents/carers and children.** Please do not drop off or pick up a child from a different household as this is crossing bubbles, which puts everyone who comes into contact with those children at unnecessary risk.

Additionally, we will continue with staggered start and end times and more details can be found below for your child's class. Please ensure that you drop off and pick up your child at their correct start and end time. If your child is old enough to walk to their classroom door themselves, parents/carers do not need to come onto the school grounds, therefore reducing the amount of people on the school yard.

Once the pupils return to school, if a bubble has to close live lessons will resume until the isolation period has ended. We will keep you fully informed as usual.

If your child or anyone in your household has any of the main symptoms of coronavirus or your child has been in close contact with a positive case, please keep your child off school and phone the school office as soon as possible.

Thank you for your continued cooperation with ensuring that we make Brougham Primary School as safe as possible.

Thursday 4th March will be the last day of live lessons, with the focus being on World Book Day activities, well-being and celebration assemblies. More details below.

Maths - Times Tables

English - Spellings

15 minutes practise per evening at home; these will be tested on Friday and spelling scores will be reported via your child's Marvellous Me portfolio.
